FVE Animal Welfare Update

Dear Colleagues, Friends,

To my great regret I cannot join you for this 3th consultation meeting. The reason is that we have our General Assembly in Tallinn and the moment you are meeting, we are flying direction Estonia.

In this document, I want to very briefly summarise our input.

Most of the Animal Welfare work within FVE is done through are Animal Welfare Working group, which was renewed in 2016 and decided upon an action plan for 2017-2020 (see annex).

More specifically **in the field of working equids**, we are working on:

- Transport guidelines for horses and factsheets (transport guides project, see later)
- Through FEEVA (the federation of equine veterinary associations) which specifically focuses on end-of-life and responsible ownership and breeding
- Through EHN (European Horse Network)
- Possible future topic for collaboration with 4pfoten and ISZ.

- FVE especially promotes a 'One Health Approach' and good preparation for potential disasters. I will attach the final conclusions of this conference.
- We also wrote as follow-up a letter to all ministers involved with Humanitarian Aid and Crisis Management with a request to take a 'One Health' approach and to not forget animals in disaster preparation.

Last I want to give you a short update on the Transport Guides Project.

FVE is core group member of the <u>Animal Transport Guides project</u> together with Eurogroup for Animals, Wageningen, CRPA and IRU. This EU 3-year project started in May 2015 until May 2018 has as aim to develop guides of good and better practice for horses, cattle, sheep, poultry and pigs. We are now at a critical moment of the project, namely the guides have been developed (awaiting European Commission adoption), 18 factsheets are ready and educational videos are almost ready. From after summer, we will start to disseminate all this materials as widely as possible. Materials will be available in 8 languages (EN, FR, ES, PO, GR, DE, IT, RO).

Can any of you help us disseminating the materials? We want to get them to as much drivers, transporters, farmers and other persons involved in animal transport.

Other projects we are working hard on that might interest you are:

- Doing a survey on tail docking and enrichment materials
- Working on pig castration
- On Internet trade of companion animals (together with 4pfoten)
- On the link between animal and human abuse
- On a positon paper re the killing of unwanted animals.
