### WHAT IS UECBY?

**UECBV** is the **European Livestock and Meat Trades Union**. It represents the national

federations of the:

- ☐ livestock traders
- livestock markets
- meat industry: slaughterhouses, cutting and preparation plants
- wholesale meat traders
- ☐ international meat traders

**UECBV** focuses on cattle, beef / horses, horsemeat / sheep and goats, sheep and goat meat / pigs, pork.

#### Today, UECBV represents 52 associations out of:

- 24 EU Member States as well as certain EFTA countries and EU candidate countries (Turkey).
- Other countries, EU trade partners in the meat sector, are also associated to the UECBV (Japan, Russia and Ukraine)

#### 3 European Associations


Livestock markets (AEMB) Casings industry (ENSCA) Ship suppliers (OCEAN)

## **Current/future activities**

- <u>UECBV is member of the new EU animal welfare platform: another tool for a better enforcement</u> of the EU legislation on the EU territory and on the territory of the trade partners;
- UECBV task force on Animal Welfare
- Participation in the expert group on alternatives to piglet castration
- Collaboration with AW NGOs on the situation of livestock markets in Bulgaria and Poland (request for meetings with the Commission Services on this issue)
- EU Commission pilot project on best practices for animal transport (May 2015/April 2018)
- Guidance document for transportability of sheep and goats
- Guidance document for transport of horses for slaughter



## **Current/future activities**

- Collaboration with the charity World Horse Welfare on the welfare of horses during slaughter
- Training in countries where EU is exporting live cattle and live sheep
  (waiting for the green light from the Commission services)
- Initiatives of the meat industry regarding the animal welfare during slaughter (CCTV in BE/F/UK/NL) and the coordination by UECBV.
