





## First OIE Regional workshop on the role of Veterinary Services on animal welfare disasters for Balkan countries 26-28 November 2018, Teramo Italy

#### Main conclusions:

- ✓ Animal welfare in disaster management contingency planning is a new topic
- ✓ Different components (technical, legislation and administrative, communication...)
  Existing experience already with past events and solid knowledge in Veterinary services on contingency planning for animal health emergencies
- ✓ Areas for further consideration :
  - coordination with Civil Protection to better define the role of veterinary services
  - role and place in the system of private veterinarians and paraprofessionals, farmers, business operators and other stakeholders including NGOs
  - specific education, training, simulation exercises
  - Communication on all levels
  - possible mutual assistance agreements within country and with neighbouring countries



#### Next steps in 2019

- Survey on present state of implementation of the OIE guidelines
  - To serve as a more precise base line for the region
  - To help countries better identify the gaps
  - May/June 2019
- Template presentation
  - To help countries to later report on their draft plan (DMAW2)
  - June/July 2019
- **DMAW2** to share on the first drafts of contingency plans
  - Exchange on structure, difficulties, good ideas...
  - Venue: Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina
  - 4-8 November (alternative 18-22 November)

Awareness Campaign on Working equids first step <u>baseline survey</u> for West Eurasia countries

 OIE Platform Secretariat and Intranational Collation for Working equids (ICWE) developed a baseline survey to collect additional data from the West Eurasia countries on the welfare of working equids

- Organising a webinar with the 8 West Eurasian countries & conducting a survey OIE Platform Secretariat and ICWE
- Collecting and analysing the answers of the survey
- Developing the 'Campaign Essentials'
